MY DAYBOOK FOR GOD

And anytime extra that's available. Or anytime that I think of Him. It will mean setting the alarm a little bit earlier, and also tearing myself away from the T.V. a bit earlier at night. (And really!!! How many of those programs do I really need to watch?) I know the above list may seem daunting, but my goal is to do my best! I know there will be days that I won't be able to get them all in. And so I'll just have to pick the ones I am able to do and know that He understands. I do know that without planning, none will be accomplished.

THE CHAPEL OF PERPETUAL EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

A Holy Hour is spending an hour devoted to prayer in the presence of the Holy Eucharist where Jesus is truly present **HIS BODY, BLOOD, SOUL AND DIVINITY.**

The Lord wants us to draw closer to Him and to get to know Him in a more intimate way in addition to regular attendance to daily and Sunday masses. Our communal worship at mass must go together with our personal worship of Jesus in **EUCHARISTIC ADORATION** in order that our love be complete. Each moment that you spend with Jesus, you grow spiritually.

Pope Francis has stated that his spiritual strength comes from his prayer before the Lord and he is not slow to recommend it to others. He states that **EUCHARISTIC ADORATION** allows us to immerse ourselves in the "Sea which is the Person of Christ."

In his Eucharistic conference of Genoa, Italy last July, he recommends that all of us "visit, if possible, every day – especially amid life's difficulties, the Blessed Sacrament of the infinite love of Christ and His mercy, to speak filially with Him, to listen to Him in silence and to peacefully entrust ourselves to Him." Without prolonged moments of adoration of prayerful encounter with the Word, of sincere conversation with the Lord, our word easily becomes meaningless; we lose energy as a result of weariness and difficulties and our fervor dies out.

Pope Francis maintains, "One cannot know the Lord without being in the habit of adoring, of adoring Him in silence."

Saint John Paul II encouraged Adoration. In *Dominicae Cenae*, he expressed: "The Church and world have a great need for Eucharistic Adoration. Jesus awaits us in this Sacrament of Love. Let us not refuse to go to meet Him in adoration, in contemplation full of faith and open to making amends for serious offences and crimes of the world. Let our Adoration never cease. In Adoration, Christ offers himself to the Father for us, involving us in His sacrifice and gives himself to us as the Bread of Life for our journey along the paths of the world." We need Him so that peace reigns in our families and in our human relations.

It is a privilege to be able to spend time with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament – a privilege that not many people have today.

PRAISE AS AN INSTRUMENT OF HARVEST

The greatest instrument of praise that God has given us is the voice. Learn to lift it up to God. Praise is entering into His presence.

Praising with our mouth, clapping, lifting up of our hands and dancing are all biblical forms of praise.

Pray: “Lord Create Praise Within Me”



Speaking in tongues does not come through the mind. It comes through the Spirit. So does the created praise that I speak. (If you never say anything more than “Alleluia” and it is a created praise, it is enough! It flows with life to the living God.) I am not thinking “I want to praise the Lord.” I come into His presence, open my spirit to Him, and my mouth automatically begins to proclaim His praises, as the spirit of God begins to flow through me. I find myself praising God and, through the ministry of praise, I come to know Him in ways that I never knew Him before.

The more we declare His blessings, the more we have to declare. We must choose to use this voice and use it for the Kingdom of God. Praise creates an atmosphere in which miracles happen. (Deuteronomy 11:24)

We will never progress in God too much that we discard praise. Praise is eternal just as God is, and we are.

A SPECIAL TEACHING THE WORD OF KNOWLEDGE

Often at our prayer meetings a member of the Word Gift Ministry speaks out something, not in the way a “prophetic word” is usually given but proceeded by the words “there is someone here” or spoken of as a “vision.” What is being spoken is known as a Word of Knowledge.

What is Word of Knowledge and how does it affect us? In the context of our prayer community it is a revelation from God, given through the Holy Spirit, as a person (or more than one person) or situation that God wishes to heal. The healing may be physical, spiritual or emotional. The Word given may be a Word of direction. The person giving the Word does not know who it is meant for but only that The Lord is asking them to speak it out.

How should we respond to a Word of Knowledge given during the prayer meeting? The Word, even if we don’t think it is meant specifically for ourself, is obviously intended for one or more of our brothers or sisters in community.

Therefore, we, as a community, should claim the Word and thank the Lord for it, asking Him to open the heart or hearts of those the Word is intended for so they will receive it.

If an individual believes the Word is meant for him or herself, that person should acknowledge it to the Lord, receive it and thank Him for it. Often this is when healing takes place. At other times this may be the beginning of a healing the Lord will do.

In the case of psychological or physical healing of a major illness, the healing should be confirmed by the doctor involved. Even if a person believes they have been healed by the Lord no one should stop taking prescribed medication or treatment until advised to do so by their doctor.

The Word of Knowledge, when manifested in a community, has a kind of “rippling effect.” In his book “Jesus is Alive” Father Emilien Tardiff states: “How can we recognize the authenticity of a Word of Knowledge? Only by the results.

The Testimonies are the thermometer which determines whether or not the Word truly came from the Lord. For example, if a healing is announced by the Word of Knowledge, but it is not authenticated with testimonies, it would

result in something doubtful, and would give rise to criticism instead of praise to the Lord.”

By witnessing to others of His healing love, we give glory to the Lord! At the same time, we help our brothers and sisters to grow in faith; not only those who hear and receive healing through the Word of Knowledge, but all the other members of the community, and also those in the Word Gift Ministry who the Lord has called to release it.
