Our Lady Of Seven Sorrows

Our Mission Statement: *"If we live by the truth and in love, we shall grow in all ways into Christ, who is the head by whom the whole body is fitted and joined together, every joint adding its own strength, for each separate part to work according to its function. So the body grows until it has built itself up, in love."* - Ephesians 4:15-16

MARY'S MANY SORROWS

While many pray to Mary during the month of May, September is also a time to reflect on the life of the Blessed Mother. September 15th is the feast of Our Lady of Sorrows. When we think of the life of Mary we truly remember how much it was filled with anguish. As a girl she is asked by God to become the mother of Jesus. A miracle and sacred responsibility bestowed on one so young. And through her life she suffered as a martyr. The feast in September is dedicated, in fact, to the spiritual martyrdom of Mary and her compassion with the suffering of her Son.

There are seven sorrows of Mary, depicted as seven arrows in 17th century art, they are:

1. The prophecy of Simeon, "You yourself shall be pierced with a sword so that the thoughts of many hearts may be laid bare." (Luke 2:35)
2. The flight into Egypt. "Get up, take the child and his mother and flee to Egypt." (Matthew 2:13)
3. Loss of the Child Jesus for three days, "You see that your father and I have been searching for you in sorrow." (Luke 2:48)
4. Mary meets Jesus on his way to Calvary.
5. Crucifixion and Death of Jesus, "Near the cross of Jesus there stood His mother." (John 19:25)
6. The body of Jesus being taken from the Cross.
7. The burial of Jesus.

These heart-wrenching scenes give the faithful a glimpse into the deep suffering of Mary as a mother. Many of us find the concept of standing at the foot of the cross as your child is lowered into your arms unimaginable. Truly during her life, Mary agonized. In each of these sorrows, though, Mary is steadfast in her belief that despite her suffering and her son's, the Lord's will must be done.

In 1815 Pope Pius VII approved a devotion to the Seven Sorrows. The readings for this feast day include the option of the Stabat Mater, a 13th century meditation to Mary that details her suffering during Christ's crucifixion. Its somber words detail Mary's pain but also invoke the hope all Christians hold for our everlasting life and renewal:

*O thou Mother! Fount of Love!
Touch my spirit from above,
Make my heart with thine accord:*

*Make me feel as thou hast felt,
Make my soul to glow and melt
With love of Christ my Lord.*

For, it is with God's love and Mary's intercession that we will all be together with Christ in heaven.

Healing Ministry with Father Fernando Suarez, MMMP

July 31, 2018 has become imprinted in my mind as a real demonstration of God's steadfast grace and mercy for His Church. People from all parishes were streaming into Our Lady of Hope Church, gathering together as a unified body, desiring to witness and participate in the healing ministry so well organized by the leaders of CKP group. Father Fernando and Father Jeffrey Shannon were to spend their last day in Sudbury before boarding their plane back to the Philippines, that same night. They were somewhat delayed from Toronto due to the fires raging in the French River area. This delay definitely allowed the leaders to get the congregation spiritually and mentally ready for the Healing ministry. When Fr. Fernando and Fr. Jeffrey arrived, the church was packed with many of the sick and the suffering from many churches. Most were definitely believers, others had accepted to come out of curiosity only.

Upon arriving, Father Jeffrey Shannon introduced Father Fernando, who without any further delay addressed the Church. He first made it clear that his gift of healing was beyond that of his human capability. He can heal others but never himself. His gift is for the people. There was nothing he had done to earn it. He became aware of the power of God flowing through him, as he was a teenage boy. However, he confessed to have resisted the gift, and decided to pursue his career in Chemistry, until finally, through the constant nudging of the Holy Spirit, he surrendered to the Lord who also was calling him to priesthood. He was convinced that the gift of healing had simply been given to him, not earned, not for himself, but for the growth of the Church of Christ. It was to strengthen, deepen and purify the faith of God's people through their deeper appreciation of Jesus' miraculous works. He declared himself only as an instrument in God's Almighty hands. Still as a young priest, he himself was amazed by how the healing power of God was channelling through him. As he totally surrendered and accepted this gift fully, and began to witness to men and women who professed that they had experienced instant healing or felt something inexplicable when he had touched the parts in their body that needed healing. Our living God, supernaturally and miraculously was healing His children from all walks of life and far reached areas of the Philippines. Some had life-threatening diseases, terminal illnesses, physical disabilities, mental problems, or spiritual blockages. For this reason, his gift had to be shared, and Father Fernandez accepted the call of his Superior who asked him to travel around the world to touch as many as God allowed him.

We, in turn on July 31, were deeply in awe, and graced by the many who were touched and healed by Father Fernando. The healing power of God was evidenced once again, being channelled through him. Many of those present expressed heartfelt joy and those experiencing such manifested power of God, were applauding, praising, and blessing the Lord as they witnessed the manifested agility of people pushing their wheelchair, walking unaided, or holding high their cane as they expressed they had no more pain, or being full of joy or that their knee or back pains had dissipated. Many of the believers were in awe. Indeed, the gifts and calling of God are irrevocable, as proclaimed in Romans 11:29.

After the healing ministry, Father Fernando, visibly exhausted, but radiant with love was still expressing thanks to God's manifested power. We were privileged to talk to many people after the healing ministry. Many expressed agreements with Father Fernando that if we would follow and obey God's Word, we would all be granted an extension to our life. The Lord is forever willing to heal those who ask with a contrite heart.

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Healing Ministry with Father Fernando Suarez, MMMP

Here are some of the points I remember about Father Fernando addressing the people before the healing ministry started. It is worth to remember, as it can be still be a channel of healing if we obey God's Word. In fact in Exodus 23: 25-26 it is expressed this way: "Serve the Lord your God. He will bless the bread and the water and remove all sickness away." Father Fernando said that the Lord wants His people to be happy. He wants them to show compassion, love, understanding, empathy and for everyone to enjoy their gift of life. This is what Jesus taught us as well. Happiness is the best gift anyone could give themselves. Enjoy life with its challenges. Show and express love, joy, and peace and leave the rest to the Holy Spirit's workings with those we love: our spouse, our children, our friends, our neighbours, and even our enemies. Stop hurting one another, slandering, judging... it only produces anxiety, bitterness, unforgiveness, insecurities, and hurts because, worst of all, it festers and makes us sick. Instead, open our ears and eyes to the blessings God gives us daily and be happy by perfecting our relationship with God and neighbours and above all, be thankful and stop complaining, cramping. Don't be grumpy or cranky.

I would say that 99% of people who heard Fr. Fernando talking, did receive some form of healing either physically and/or spiritually. Father Fernando who fatherly presented himself to us, convinced many of us through his humourous, personal touch and warm nature especially when he used his own cellular phone and pretended to take a picture of all the sad looking people. He told us that many of those sad, unforgiving faces would not be healed today. The Lord wants us to be happy first. He said that freedom would come for many more who did not experience healing in a tangible way, if only they would allow the healing of the Spirit in their hearts first. The Lord requires and asks us to first forgive and be happy. He said that many more ailments would be healed spiritually if we only would obey the Word of the Lord. (Ezekiel 36 says it this way: The Lord will take away your heart of stone and replace it with a heart of flesh and many would know He is their God).

Let us keep one another in prayer and do not forget our priests as well. We are all being transformed as a body of Christ and must keep unity at all cost. Thank God for His steadfast love, grace and mercy! And for gracing us with the visit of one of His chosen servants.
